GAFFNEY CALLS FOR END IN BICKERING

Candidate: Time to Address Real Issue Regarding Electrical Rates

Today Loretta Gaffney, a Republican candidate for State Delegate in District 13, criticized the legislature for bickering with the Governor regarding calling the legislature back into session to address the BGE rates.

“Now they are fighting about how fast the Governor is calling the legislature back. It is time to put aside the political gamesmanship and the partisan bickering. None of this bickering is getting the job done for the people. We need to address the BGE rates and now,” stated Gaffney.

This week the legislature started debating with the Governor on how fast a Special Session can be called to consider legislation to provide relief on the increasing BGE rates.

“These people just don’t get it. Maryland residents are being squeezed by the rising costs of gas and BGE rates. They don’t want to hear bickering. They want results,” said Gaffney. “We have to move forward in a spirit of cooperation, because we are all in this together.”
