CANDIDATE GAFFNEY FILES AT STATE BOARD

Candidate Files Certificate of Candidacy on the Anniversary of the 14th Amendment to U.S. Constitution

Today Loretta Gaffney will formally file to receive her certificate of candidacy for State Delegate in Maryland's 13th district on the anniversary that began the passage for the 14th Amendment to the United States Constitution. Gaffney intends to be an "agent of change" in the House of Delegates.

"I am proud to file my candidacy for State Delegate today," said Gaffney. "As the next State Delegate, my priorities will include working to lower our state's tax burden, working to control state spending, and making sure our schools are properly funded."

"I am tired of the endless empty rhetoric, the wasting of taxpayers' money, and the business as usual in the House of Delegates which has become an exclusive club that works for itself, not the citizens. It is time to put people ahead of politics," said Gaffney. "Time and time again we have seen the failure of the House. They did not handle the electric deregulation. Instead of working with the Governor for the best interest of the people, they decided to play politics. We can and must do better."

Gaffney plans to follow the 14th amendment and promote due consideration of every bill. "That means equal protection of all citizens. That means having access to voting while maintaining the integrity of each vote. And that means addressing major issues such as illegal immigration and protection of marriage," stated Gaffney.

Along with providing common sense leadership at the State House, Gaffney's top issues are cutting taxes, controlling spending, fighting for our seniors and veterans, working for sensible and predictable economic development.

Last week Gaffney took the American's tax Reform "No New Taxes" pledge.

Gaffney is a devoted wife, mother and grandmother and Entrepreneur. For years she served as a Delegate's Executive Assistant in Annapolis and understands the job. Gaffney is a veteran.
